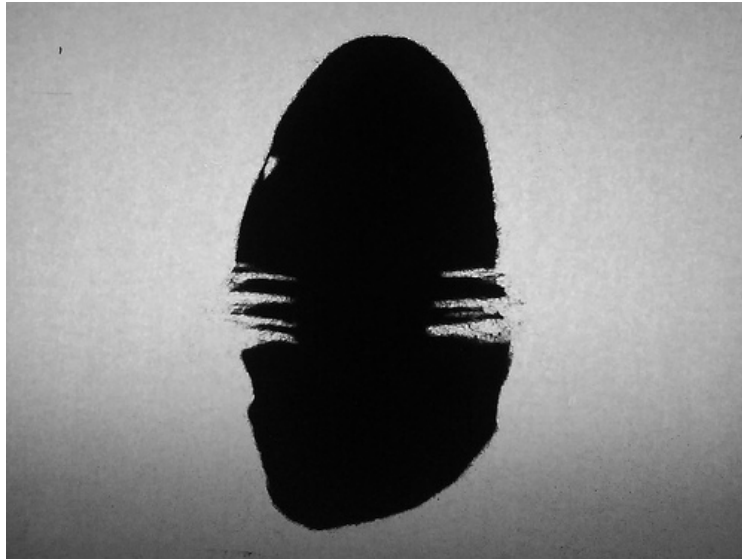


Poetry by Amani Dafina Legagneur
